WHAT IS ONEtoONE?

One to One is a person to person discipleship experience. It is done in blocks of six week commitments. Typically two people will meet once a week for six weeks, read the Bible, discuss it and share life. There are two primary connections: 1) Mentor and Mentoree 2) Peer to Peer.

WHAT DO WE DO WHEN WE MEET? (a general guideline)

READ: Pick a book of the Bible and read through a section of it.

REFLECT: Share insights with each other on the passage and it's personal application.

CONNECT: Connect about day to day life, personal struggles and general life issues.

ENCOURAGE: Encourage one another by listening, sharing and being open and honest.

PRAY: Share prayer requests and if possible pray out loud for each other.

EXPECTATIONS

Mentor Expectations:

- Pray daily for mentee.
- Lead study of God's Word with protege.
- Keep personal sharing confidential.
- Be authentic.
- Be humble.
- Rely on the Holy Spirit.
- Recognize God's Word as the final authority.
- Support the church's teachings.

Mentoree Expectations:

- Be available.
- Be humble.
- Seek God.
- Bring Questions.
